SUBJECT: Recommendation for Appointment to Project Connect Community Advisory Committee

On July 11, 2024, the Project Connect Community Advisory Committee (CAC) voted unanimously to recommend Catalina Berry to fill a mid-term vacancy on the CAC that resulted from the resignation of former member João Paulo Connolly.

The CAC followed Section 3.7 of the updated CAC Bylaws that allows the CAC to make a mid-term vacancy recommendation for final approval by the ATP Board, CapMetro Board, and Austin City Council. To reach this recommendation, the CAC created an Appointments Working Group to review applications from the most recent CAC applicant pool and consider the current expertise on the CAC and potential gaps to identify the best candidate for this current vacancy. The candidate recommendation was then reviewed and voted on by the full CAC.

If approved for appointment, Catalina Berry's term will expire on December 31, 2027.
